(134th General Assembly) (Amended House Bill Number 170)

AN ACT

To provide assistance to schools and other entities in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

SECTION 201.10. All items in the sections of this act numbered in the 200s are hereby appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in these sections, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2020 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2021. The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any other operating appropriations made for the FY 2020-FY 2021 biennium.

L. No. 116-136, the federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021," Pub. L. No. 116-260, and the federal "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," Pub. L. No. 117-2.

(B) The Department shall first obtain approval from the Controlling Board prior to the expenditure or encumbrance of the funds appropriated in appropriation item 200640 under Section 213.10 of this act and any other federal funds the Department receives from the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund under the federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021," Pub. L. No. 116-260, and the federal "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," Pub. L. No. 117-2, for the following purposes:

(1) Emergency needs determined by the Department as authorized under Title III, Sec. 313(e) of the federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021," Pub. L. No. 116-260;

(2) The spending authorized under Title II, Sec. 2001(f)(1)-(3) of the federal "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," Pub. L. No. 117-2.

SECTION 250.10. Within the limits set forth in this act, the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures from operating appropriations contained in the sections of this act numbered in the 200s shall be accounted for as though made in H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly. The operating appropriations made in these sections are subject to all provisions of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly that are generally applicable to such appropriations.

SECTION 503.10.

GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY EDUCATION RELIEF FUND REAPPROPRIATIONS

Amounts equal to the unexpended, unencumbered portions of appropriations from the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund (Fund 3HQ0) at the end of fiscal year 2021 are hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2022.

Amounts equal to the unexpended, unencumbered portions of appropriations from the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund (Fund 3HQ0) at the end of fiscal year 2022 are hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2023.

CARES ACT SCHOOL RELIEF FUND REAPPROPRIATIONS

Amounts equal to the unexpended, unencumbered portions of appropriations from the CARES Act School Relief Fund (Fund 3HS0) at the end of fiscal year 2021 are hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2022.

Amounts equal to the unexpended, unencumbered portions of appropriations from the CARES Act School Relief Fund (Fund 3HS0) at the end of fiscal year 2022 are hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2023.

PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND REAPPROPRIATIONS

Amounts equal to the unexpended, unencumbered portions of appropriations from the Public Health Emergency Response Fund (Fund 3HP0) at the end of fiscal year 2021 are hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2022.

Amounts equal to the unexpended, unencumbered portions of appropriations from the Public Health Emergency Response Fund (Fund 3HP0) at the end of fiscal year 2022 are hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2023.

SECTION 733.20. The Auditor of State may audit spending by the Department of Education and each school district of the amounts appropriated under Section 213.10 of this act and any other funds the Department received from the federal "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act," Pub. L. No. 116-136, the federal "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," Pub. L. No. 117-2, and the federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021," Pub. L. No. 116-260.
