(A) The Department of Education shall first obtain 18 approval from the Controlling Board prior to the expenditure or 19 encumbrance of the funds appropriated in appropriation item 20 200651 under Section 213.10 of this act and any other federal 21 funds the Department receives from the Emergency Assistance to 22 Non-Public Schools Program under the federal "Coronavirus Aid, 23 Relief, and Economic Security Act," Pub. L. No. 116-136, the 24 federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021," Pub. L. No. 25 116-260, and the federal "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," 26 Pub. L. No. 117-2. 27

(B) The Department shall first obtain approval from the Controlling Board prior to the expenditure or encumbrance of the funds appropriated in appropriation item 200640 under Section 213.10 of this act and any other federal funds the Department receives from the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund under the federal "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021," Pub. L. No. 116-260, and the federal "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," Pub. L. No. 117-2, for the following purposes:

Section 250.10. Within the limits set forth in this act, 45 the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 46 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 47 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 48 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained.
