To enact section 5.53 of the Revised Code to 1

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.53 of the Revised Code be 3
enacted to read as follows: 4

Sec. 5.53. The twenty-eighth day of July is designated as 5
