BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3703.01 and 3703.03 of the	4	
Revised Code be amended to read as follows:	5	
Sec. 3703.01. (A) Except as otherwise provided in this	6	
section, the division of industrial compliance in the department	7	
of commerce shall do all of the following:		
(1) Inspect all nonresidential buildings within the	9	
meaning of section 3781.06 of the Revised Code;	10	
(2) Condemn all unsanitary or defective plumbing that is	11	
found in connection with those places;	12	
(3) Order changes in plumbing necessary to insure the	13	
safety of the public health.		
(B)(1)(a) The division of industrial compliance, boards of	15	
health of city and general health districts, and county building	16	
departments shall not inspect plumbing or collect fees for		
inspecting plumbing in particular types of buildings in any	18	

municipal corporation that is certified by the board of building standards under section 3781.10 of the Revised Code to exercise enforcement authority for plumbing in those types of buildings.

(b) The division shall not inspect plumbing or collect 22 fees for inspecting plumbing in particular types of buildings in 23 any health district that has notified the division in writing of 24 its intent to inspect plumbing within its jurisdiction and that 25 employs or retains under contract one or more plumbing 26 inspectors, certified pursuant to division (D) of this section 27 <u>3781.10 of the Revised Code</u>, to enforce Chapters 3781. and 3791. 28 29 of the Revised Code and the rules adopted pursuant to those chapters relating to plumbing in those types of buildings. 30

(c) The division shall not inspect plumbing or collect31fees for inspecting plumbing in particular types of buildings in32any health district where the county building department is33authorized to inspect those types of buildings pursuant to a34contract described in division (C) (1) of this section.35

(d) The division shall not inspect plumbing or collect36fees for inspecting plumbing in particular types of buildings in37any health district where the board of health has entered into a38contract with the board of health of another district to conduct39inspections pursuant to division (C) (2) of this section.40

(2) No county building department shall inspect plumbing
or collect fees for inspecting plumbing in any type of building
in a health district unless the department is authorized to
inspect that type of building pursuant to a contract described
in division (C) (1) of this section.

(3) No municipal corporation shall inspect plumbing or46collect fees for inspecting plumbing in types of buildings for47

which it is not certified by the board of building standards 48 under section 3781.10 of the Revised Code to exercise 49 enforcement authority. 50 (4) No board of health of a health district shall inspect 51 plumbing or collect fees for inspecting plumbing in types of 52 buildings for which it does not have a plumbing inspector 53 certified pursuant to division (D) of this section. 54 (C) (1) The board of health of a health district may enter 55 into a contract with a board of county commissioners to 56 57 authorize the county building department to inspect plumbing in buildings within the health district. The contract may designate 58 that the department inspect either residential or nonresidential 59 buildings, as those terms are defined in section 3781.06 of the 60 Revised Code, or both types of buildings, so long as the 61 62 department employs or contracts with a plumbing inspector certified pursuant to division (D) of this section to inspect 63 the types of buildings the contract designates. The board of 64 health may enter into a contract regardless of whether the 65 health district employs any certified plumbing inspectors to 66 enforce Chapters 3781. and 3791. of the Revised Code. 67 (2) The board of health of a health district, regardless 68 of whether it employs any certified plumbing inspectors to 69 enforce Chapters 3781. and 3791. of the Revised Code, may enter 70 into a contract with the board of health of another health 71 district to authorize that board to inspect plumbing in 72 73 buildings within the contracting board's district. The contract may designate the inspection of either residential or 74 nonresidential buildings as defined in section 3781.06 of the 75 Revised Code, or both types of buildings, so long as the board 76

certified pursuant to division (D) of this section to inspect 78 the types of buildings the contract designates. 79 (D) The superintendent of industrial compliance shall-80 adopt rules prescribing minimum qualifications based on 81 education, training, experience, or demonstrated ability, that 82 the superintendent shall use in certifying or recertifying 83 plumbing inspectors to do plumbing inspections for health-84 districts and county building departments that are authorized to 85 perform inspections pursuant to a contract under division (C)(1) 86 of this section, and for continuing education of plumbing 87 inspectors. Those minimum qualifications shall be related to the 88 types of buildings for which a person seeks certification. 89 (E) The superintendent may enter into reciprocal-90 registration, licensure, or certification agreements with other 91 states and other agencies of this state relative to plumbing 92 inspectors if both of the following apply: 93 (1) The requirements for registration, licensure, or-94 certification of plumbing inspectors under the laws of the other 95 96 state or laws administered by the other agency are substantially equal to the requirements the superintendent adopts under-97 division (D) of this section for certifying plumbing inspectors. 98 (2) The other state or agency extends similar reciprocity-99 to persons certified under this chapter. 100 (F) The superintendent may select and contract with one or 101 more persons to do all of the following regarding examinations 102 for certification of plumbing inspectors: 103 (1) Prepare, administer, score, and maintain the-104 confidentiality of the examination; 105 (2) Maintain responsibility for all expenses required to 106

regulations shall not be less than those prescribed in Chapters	114

$\frac{(H)}{(E)}$ Notwithstanding any other provision of this	117
section, the division shall make a plumbing inspection of any	118
building or other place that there is reason to believe is in a	119
condition to be a menace to the public health.	120
Sec. 3703.03. In the administration of sections 3703.01 to	121
3703.08 of the Revised Code, the division of industrial	
compliance shall enforce rules governing plumbing adopted by the	123
board of building standards under authority of sections 3781.10	124
and 3781.11 of the Revised Code , and register those persons	125
engaged in or at the plumbing business.	126
Plans and specifications for all plumbing to be installed	127
in or for buildings coming within such sections shall be	128
submitted to and approved by the division before the contract	129
for plumbing is let.	130
Section 2. That existing sections 3703.01 and 3703.03 of	131
the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	132
