A BILL

To enact section 109.661 of the Revised Code to 1
create the anti-prostitution grant program fund 2
and to make an appropriation. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 109.661 of the Revised Code be 4
enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 109.661. (A) There is hereby created in the state 6
treasury the anti-prostitution grant program fund consisting of 7
money appropriated to the fund by the general assembly. The 8
attorney general shall administer the anti-prostitution grant 9
program fund. 10

(B) The attorney general shall adopt rules pursuant to 11
Chapter 119. of the Revised Code that shall establish procedures 12
for anti-prostitution programs, such as programs certified by 13
the Ohio supreme court as specialized dockets aimed at helping 14
victims of human trafficking and programs for educating persons 15
alleged to have engaged in soliciting, to apply to the attorney 16
general for funding from the anti-prostitution grant program 17
fund and procedures for the attorney general to distribute money 18
out of the fund to anti-prostitution programs. 19

(C) An anti-prostitution program that receives funds from 20
the anti-prostitution grant program fund shall use the funds 21
received for programming aimed at reducing supply or demand for 22
prostitution, as determined by the attorney general. 23

Section 2. All items in this section are hereby 24
appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 25
treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all 26
appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 27
for fiscal year 2022 and those in the second column are for 28
fiscal year 2023. The appropriations made in this act are in 29
addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2022-FY 30
2023 biennium. 31

ANTI-PROSTITUTION GRANT PROGRAM 34

On July 1 of each fiscal year of the biennium ending June 35
30, 2023, or as soon as possible thereafter, the Director of 36

Budget and Management shall transfer \$5,000,000 cash from the 37
General Revenue Fund to the Anti-Prostitution Grant Program Fund 38
(5WG0) created in section 109.661 of the Revised Code. The 39
foregoing appropriation item 055508, Anti-Prostitution Grant 40
Program, shall be used for the purpose described in section 41
109.661 of the Revised Code. 42

Section 3. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 43
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 44
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 45
made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 46
which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 47
from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for 48
as though made in the main operating appropriations act of the 49
134th General Assembly. 50

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all 51
provisions of the main operating appropriations act of the 134th 52
General Assembly that are generally applicable to such 53
appropriations. 54
