BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3727.11, 3727.12, 3727.13, and	7
3727.14 be amended and section 3727.131 of the Revised Code be	8

hospital shall comply with sections 3727.11 to 3727.13 of the	218
Revised Code as if the certification and recognition described	219
in this section were one of the three-four-levels described in	220
sections 3727.11 to 3727.13 of the Revised Code.	221
Section 2. That existing sections 3727.11, 3727.12,	222
3727.13, and 3727.14 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	223
Section 3. The enactment by this act of section 3727.131	224
of the Revised Code takes effect six months after the effective	225
date of this section.	226

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
