BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3792.05 and 4113.73 of the	7	
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:		
Sec. 3792.05. (A) As used in this section:	9	
(1) "Place of public accommodation" has the same meaning	10	
as in section 4112.01 of the Revised Code.	11	
(2) "Private college" has the same meaning as in section 3365.01 of the Revised Code.	12 13	
(3) "Proof of COVID-19 vaccination status" means a paper	14	
document or a digital application available on a smartphone,		
tablet, or other device, that demonstrates, including through	16	

the use of a scannable code, an individual's COVID-19	17
accination status.	
(4) "School" means either or both of the following:	19
(a) A chartered nonpublic school as defined in section	20
3310.01 of the Revised Code;	
(b) A public school as defined in section 3792.04 of the	22
Revised Code.	23
(5) "State institution of higher education" has the same	24
meaning as in section 3345.011 of the Revised Code.	25
(B) Notwithstanding any provision of the Revised Code to	26
the contrary, both of the following apply:	27
(1) No school, private college, or state institution of	28
higher education shall prohibit a student from enrolling in or	29
attending classes at the school, college, or institution for	
either of the following reasons:	31
(a) The student has not been or will not be vaccinated	32

(2) No proprietor or employee, keeper, or manager of a	36
place of public accommodation shall deny a person the full

vaccination status. 44 Sec. 4113.73. (A) As used in this section: 45 (1) "Employer" means any person who has one or more 46 employees. "Employer" includes an agent of an employer, the 47 state or any agency or instrumentality of the state, and any 48 municipal corporation, county, township, school district, or 49 other political subdivision or any agency or instrumentality 50 thereof. 51 (2) "Proof of <u>COVID-19</u> vaccination status" means a paper 52 document or a digital application available on a smartphone, 53 tablet, or other device, that demonstrates, including through 54 the use of a scannable code, an individual's COVID-19 55 56 vaccination status. (B) No employer shall discharge without just cause, refuse 57 to hire, or otherwise discriminate against any person with 58 respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of 59 employment, or any matter directly or indirectly related to 60 employment, for either of the following reasons: 61 (1) The person has not been or will not be vaccinated 62 against COVID-19. 63 (2) The person refuses to show proof of COVID-19 64 vaccination status. 65 Section 2. This act shall be known as the COVID-19 66 Vaccination and Passport Protection Act. 67
