### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 907.09 of the Revised Code be	5	
amended to read as follows:	6	
Sec. 907.09. (A) Sections 907.03, 907.07, and 907.08 of	7	
the Revised Code do not apply to:	8	
(1) Agricultural, vegetable, or flower seed not intended	9	
for sowing purposes;	10	
(2) Unprocessed agricultural, vegetable, or flower seed in	11	
storage or being transported to or consigned to a seed	12	
processing establishment, provided that the label accompanying a		
shipment of the seed shall bear the statement "seed for	14	
processing" and provided further that any label or other	15	
representation that is made with respect to the unprocessed seed	16	
shall be subject to sections 907.01 to 907.17 of the Revised		
Code;	18

(3) Agricultural, vegetable, or flower seed that is in	19	
interstate transport and that is governed by 7 C.F.R. 201.33;	20	
(4) Agricultural, vegetable, or flower seed of a plant	21	
that is native to Ohio, whose ownership is freely transferred,	22	
without remuneration of any sort, when used in one of the		
<pre>following ways:</pre>	24	
(a) To support conservation of butterflies or other	25	
<pre>insects;</pre>	26	
(b) To plant and create native plants habitats;	27	
(c) To propagate native plants for their specific	28	
conservation.	29	
(B) In the case of agricultural, vegetable, or flower seed	30	
that is being exported in bulk or containers directly to a	31	
foreign country and that is in quantities of twenty thousand	32	
pounds or more regardless of the number of lots included, the		
labeling requirements established under section 907.03 of the	34	
Revised Code do not apply, provided that all of the following	35	
requirements are satisfied:	36	
(1) The omission, from each container or bulk unit, of a	37	
label with the required information is done with the knowledge	38	
and consent of the buyer of the seed prior to the transportation	39	
or delivery for transportation of the seed in international	40	
commerce.	41	
(2) Each container has stenciled on it or bears a label	42	
containing a lot designation, variety identification, and kind		
identification.	44	
(3) The invoice or other records accompanying and	45	
pertaining to the seed bear the information concerning the	46

respective seeds that is required under section 907.03 of the	47
Revised Code.	48
(4) Records are kept available to be provided to the	49
department of agriculture upon request in order to show proof	50
that the seed is being exported to a foreign country for	51
distribution.	52
Section 2. That existing section 907.09 of the Revised	53
Code is hereby repealed.	54
