**A BILL**

To enact section 3792.06 of the Revised Code to  
prohibit a private college or state institution  
of higher education from discriminating against  
an individual based on COVID-19 vaccination  
status.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 3792.06 of the Revised Code be  
enacted to read as follows:

**Sec. 3792.06.** (A) As used in this section:

(1) "COVID-19 immunity passport" means a document, digital  
record, or software application indicating vaccination against  
or recovery from COVID-19.

(2) "Private college" has the same meaning as in section  
3365.01 of the Revised Code.

(3) "State institution of higher education" has the same  
meaning as in section 3345.011 of the Revised Code.

(B) No private college or state institution of higher  
education shall discriminate against an individual, including by  
excluding, penalizing, or segregating the individual, refusing

<u>privilege, or service, based on either of the following:</u>	21
<u>(1) Whether or not the individual has received one or more</u>	22
<u>doses of a vaccine against COVID-19, including any of its</u>	23

<u>(2) Whether or not the individual uses a COVID-19 immunity</u>	25
