A BILL

To enact section 5.53 of the Revised Code to 1
designate June 14th as "President Donald J. 2
Trump Day." 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.53 of the Revised Code be 4
enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 5.53. (A) The fourteenth day of June is designated as 6
"Donald J. Trump Day." 7

(B) Former President Donald J. Trump was our 45th 8
President of the United States and accomplished many great feats 9
and addressed issues that have led our state and nation to 10
unparalleled prosperity. 11

A record 3,154,834 Ohio voters cast their ballot to re- 12
elect Donald J. Trump as President - an historic number of votes 13
received for President in Ohio. 14

Members of this 134th Legislature see it fit to honor 15
President Donald J. Trump for his substantial contributions to 16

this state and country including: historic tax cuts, criminal 17
justice reform, record-low unemployment, an all-time high stock 18
market, no new wars, peace deals in the Middle East, relocated 19
the U.S. embassy in Israel to Jerusalem, USMCA trade deal, fixed 20
veterans' healthcare system, appointed three Supreme Court 21
Justices, and protected the freedoms and rights preordained 22
within our U.S. Constitution. 23

For these reasons, we deem it pertinent and appropriate to 24
represent Ohioans by designating June 14th to recognize the 45th 25
President. 26
