# BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 201.10. All items in the sections of this act	3
numbered in the 200s are hereby appropriated as designated out	4
of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the	5
designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in these	6
sections, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2020 and	7
those in the second column are for fiscal year 2021. The	8
operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any	9
other operating appropriations made for the FY 2020-FY 2021	10
biennium.	11

	BAR AND RESTAURANT ASSISTANCE						
	On the effective date of this section, or as soon as						

On the effective date of this section, or as soon as 15 possible thereafter, of the funding for liquor permit holders 16 authorized by the Controlling Board on October 26, 2020, the 17 Director of the Development Services Agency shall determine the 18 portion of funding that went unused under Fund 5CV1 19 appropriation item 195631, Coronavirus Relief - Small Business 20 Grant, and award grants to bars and restaurants in a manner to 21 be determined by the Development Services Agency. Liquor permit 22 23 holders who previously received grants under this appropriation item are eligible to receive grants under this appropriation 24 item. 25

The foregoing appropriation item 195561, Bar and26Restaurant Assistance, shall be used by the Development Services27

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Agency to provide grants to bars and restaurants that have been 28 impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Grants shall be awarded in 29 amounts of \$10,000, \$20,000, and \$30,000 and shall be awarded 30 based on factors such as demonstrated loss of revenue and the 31 number of employees eligible bars and restaurants employ. 32

Upon the closing of the application period for grants 33 under appropriation item 195561, Bar and Restaurant Assistance, 34 or as soon as possible thereafter, the Director of the 35 Development Services Agency shall determine the amount of grant 36 funding that went unused under the appropriation item, and award 37 grants to bars and restaurants in a manner to be determined by 38 the Development Services Agency. Bars and restaurants that 39 previously received grants under this appropriation item are 40 eligible to receive grants under this appropriation item. 41

### LODGING INDUSTRY GRANTS

The foregoing appropriation item 195562, Lodging Industry43Grants, shall be used by the Development Services Agency to44provide grants for lodging industry businesses impacted by the45COVID-19 pandemic. Grants shall be awarded in amounts of46\$10,000, \$20,000, and \$30,000 and shall be awarded based on47factors such as a demonstrated loss of revenue and occupancy48rates.49

Section 250.10. Within the limits set forth in this act, 50 the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 51 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 52 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 53 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 54 from operating appropriations contained in the sections of this 55 act numbered in the 200s shall be accounted for as though made 56 in H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly. The operating 57

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appropriations made in these sections are subject to all	58	
provisions of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly that are	59	
generally applicable to such appropriations.		
Section 812.10. Sections 201.10, 209.10, and 250.10 of	61	
this act are exempt from the referendum under Ohio Constitution,	62	
Article II, section 1d and therefore take effect immediately	63
