A BILL

To enact section 3792.02 of the Revised Code to
prohibit certain mandatory vaccinations and
other activities related to an individual's
vaccination status and to make an appropriation
related to coronavirus local fiscal recovery.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3792.02 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 3792.02. (A) To the extent permitted by federal law
and notwithstanding any conflicting provision of the Revised
Code, a private or public entity shall not do either or both of
the following:

(1) Require an individual to receive a vaccine for which
the United States food and drug administration has not granted
full approval;

(2) Require an individual who has not received a vaccine described in division (A) (1) of this section to engage in or refrain from engaging in activities or precautions that differ from the activities or precautions of an individual who has elected to receive such a vaccine.

(B) Divisions (A) (1) and (2) of this section do not apply with respect to a private residence.

Section 2. All items in this act are hereby appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2022 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2023. The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any other operating appropriations made for the FY 2022-FY 2023 biennium.

The foregoing appropriation item 042526, Coronavirus Local 33
Fiscal Recovery, shall be used by the Director of Budget and 34
Management to disburse funding to nonentitlement units of local 35
government in Ohio, including cities, villages, and townships, 36
on a population basis in accordance with the provisions of the 37
"American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," Pub. L. No. 117-2, and 38
consistent with guidance issued under that act. 39

Section 4. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 40
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 41
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 42
made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 43
which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 44
from operating appropriations contained in this act shall be 45
accounted for as though made in the main operating 46
appropriations act of the 134th General Assembly. The operating 47
appropriations made in this act are subject to all provisions of 48
the main operating appropriations act of the 134th General 49
Assembly that are generally applicable to such appropriations. 50
