BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 301.221, 319.41, 321.50, 507.14,	6
733.82, 3354.101, 3357.101, 3358.061, 3375.361, and 6119.61 of	7
the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 301.221. The treasurer, auditor, or other officer	9
having the duties of a county treasurer or a county auditor, for	10
a county that has adopted a charter under Article X, Ohio	11
Constitution, shall not be held liable for a loss of public	12
funds when the officer has performed all official duties	13
required of the office with reasonable care, but shall be liable	14
only when a loss of public funds results from the officer's	15

negligence or other wrongful act.

Sec. 319.41. A county auditor shall not be held liable for	17
a loss of public funds when the county auditor has performed all	18
official duties required of the county auditor with reasonable	19
care, but shall be liable only when a loss of public funds	20
results from the county auditor's negligence or other wrongful	21
<u>act.</u>	22

Sec. 321.50. A county treasurer shall not be held liable for a loss of public funds when the county treasurer has performed all official duties required of the county treasurer with reasonable care, but shall be liable only when a loss of public funds results from the county treasurer's negligence or other wrongful act.

Sec. 507.14. A township fiscal officer or deputy fiscal 29 officer shall not be held liable for a loss of public funds when 30 the township fiscal officer or deputy fiscal officer has 31 performed all official duties required of the township fiscal 32 officer or deputy fiscal officer with reasonable care, but shall 33 be liable only when a loss of public funds results from the 34 township fiscal officer's or deputy fiscal officer's negligence 35 or other wrongful act. 36

Sec. 733.82. The treasurer of a municipal corporation or_ 37 city auditor, or other officer of a municipal corporation having 38 the duties of a municipal treasurer or of a city auditor, shall 39 not be held liable for a loss of public funds when the officer 40 has performed all official duties required of the officer with 41 reasonable care, but shall be liable only when a loss of public 42 funds results from the officer's negligence or other wrongful 43 44 act.
