## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3702.3011 and 3727.25 of the		
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	4	
Sec. 3702.3011. (A) As used in this section:	5	
(1) "Surgical smoke" means the airborne byproduct of an	6	
energy-generating device used in a surgical procedure, including		
smoke plume, bioaerosols, gases, laser-generated contaminants,		
and dust.		
<u>(2) "Surgical smoke evacuation system" means equipment</u>	10	
designed to capture and neutralize surgical smoke at the point		
of origin, before the smoke makes contact with the eyes or		
respiratory tract of individuals.		
<u>(B) Not later than one year after the effective date of</u>	14	
this section, each ambulatory surgical facility shall adopt and		
implement a policy designed to prevent human exposure to		
surgical smoke during any planned surgical procedure that is		

likely to generate surgical smoke. The policy shall include the		
use of a surgical smoke evacuation system.		
(C) The director of health may adopt any rules the	20

director considers necessary to implement this section. The		
rules shall be adopted in accordance with Chapter 119. of the		
Revised Code.	23	
Sec. 3727.25. As used in this section, "surgical smoke"	24	
and "surgical smoke evacuation system" have the same meanings as	25	
in section 3702.3011 of the Revised Code.		
Not later than one year after the effective date of this	27	
section, each hospital that performs surgeries shall adopt and		
implement a policy designed to prevent human exposure to		
surgical smoke during any planned surgical procedure that is		
likely to generate surgical smoke. The policy shall include the		
use of a surgical smoke evacuation system.	32	
The director of health may adopt any rules the director	33
