BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4732.10 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4732.10. (A) The state board of psychology shall	6
appoint an entrance examiner who shall determine the sufficiency	7
of an applicant's qualifications for admission to the	8
appropriate examination. A member of the board or the executive	
director may be appointed as the entrance examiner.	
(B) Requirements for admission to examination for a	11
psychologist license shall be that the applicant:	
(1) Is at least twenty-one years of age;	13

(a) Received an earned doctoral degree from an institution	15

The board shall adopt guidelines for the 45 kind of supervised professional experience that fulfill this 46

requirement, except that the board shall not require any 47 postdoctoral supervised professional experience to fulfill this 48 requirement. 49 (4) If applying under division (B) (2) (b) or (c) (B) (2) (c) 50 of this section, has had at least two years of supervised 51 professional experience in psychological work of a type 52 satisfactory to the board, at least one year of which must be 53 postdoctoral. The board shall adopt quidelines for the kind of 54 supervised professional experience that fulfill this 55 56 requirement. (C) Requirements for admission to examination for a school 57 psychologist license shall be that the applicant: 58 (1) Has received from an educational institution 59 accredited or recognized by national or regional accrediting 60 agencies as maintaining satisfactory standards, including those 61 approved by the state board of education for the training of 62 school psychologists, at least a master's degree in school 63 psychology, or a degree considered equivalent by the board; 64 (2) Is at least twenty-one years of age; 65 (3) Has completed at least sixty quarter hours, or the 66 semester hours equivalent, at the graduate level, of accredited 67 study in course work relevant to the study of school psychology; 68 69 (4) Has completed an internship in an educational institution approved by the Ohio department of education for 70 school psychology supervised experience or one year of other 71 training experience acceptable to the board, such as supervised 72 professional experience under the direction of a licensed 73 psychologist or licensed school psychologist; 74

(5) Furnishes proof of at least twenty-seven months, 75

exclusive of internship, of full-time experience as a	76

(D) If the entrance examiner finds that the applicant	81	
meets the requirements set forth in this section, the applicant		
shall be admitted to the appropriate examination.		
(E) The board shall adopt under Chapter 119. of the	84	
Revised Code rules for determining for the purposes of division		
(B)(2)(b)<u>(</u>B)(2)(c) of this section whether a degree is		
equivalent to a degree in psychology from an institution in the		
United States.
