BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.2269 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 5.2269. (A) The month of May is designated as	6
"Substance Abuse Awareness and Education Month." The first	7
Friday of May is designated as "Prescription Drug Abuse	8
Awareness and Education Day."	9
(B) The thirty-first day of August is designated as "Ohio	10
Overdose Awareness Day" to raise public awareness of the	11

<u>epidemic and to remember the lives lost to the epidemic. On the</u>	12
thirty-first day of August, in recognition of Ohio Overdose	13
Awareness Day, a state flag displayed at a state building or	
public institution shall be flown at half-staff from sunrise	
<u>until sunset.</u>
