INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 403 - Representatives Fowler Arthur, Miller, A.

To amend section 3319.313 of the Revised Code to require a school district superintendent or administrator of a public or chartered nonpublic school to file a report with the Department of Education regarding a teacher that retired under threat of disciplinary investigation.

H. B. No. 404 - Representatives Boggs, Smith, K.

Cosponsors: Representatives Boyd, Miranda, Leland, Sobecki, Brown, Miller, A., Ingram, West, Miller, J., Howse, Sheehy, Smith, M., Weinstein, Skindell.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.59 of the Revised Code to create the "Equality Ohio" license plate.

H. B. No. 405 - Representatives Stewart, Johnson.

To amend section 339.02 of the Revised Code to clarify the nature of the appointing authority for boards of county hospital trustees.

H. B. No. 406 - Representative Schmidt.

Cosponsors: Representatives Gross, Fowler Arthur.

To amend sections 2907.01 and 2907.08 of the Revised Code to make changes to the offense of voyeurism.

Said bills were considered the first time.
