INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 705 - Representatives Miller, A., Miller, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ingram, Davis, Troy, O'Brien, Sheehy, Lightbody, Weinstein, Russo, Denson, Sobecki.

To enact section 3313.5316 of the Revised Code to authorize the Ohio High School Athletic Association to establish the rules of play and athlete eligibility regulations for interscholastic athletics for grades seven to twelve.

H. B. No. 706 - Representative Stein.

To amend sections 718.01 and 718.03 of the Revised Code to subject foreign temporary agricultural workers to municipal income taxes and to modify the withholding rules for such workers.

Said bills were considered the first time.
