**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 713** - Representative Ginter.

To amend section 4513.34 of the Revised Code to require the Ohio Department of Transportation and local authorities to issue special regional heavy hauling permits within every county that borders Pennsylvania.

**H. B. No. 714** - Representatives Young, T., John.

Cosponsor: Representative Addison.

To amend sections 2305.234, 2925.01, 2925.02, 2925.03, 2925.11, 2925.12, 2925.14, 2925.23, 2925.36, 2925.55, 2925.56, 2929.42, 3701.048, 3701.74, 3715.872, 3719.06, 3719.121, 3719.13, 3719.81, 4729.01, 4729.51, 4731.22, 4731.251, 4743.09, 4755.48, 4761.01, 4761.03, 4761.032, 4761.06, 4761.061, 4761.07, 4761.09, 4761.13, 4761.14, 4761.17, 4761.30, 4761.99, 4765.51, 4769.01, 5123.47, 5164.95, and 5903.12; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 4761.30 (4761.25); and to enact new section 4761.30 and sections 4761.033, 4761.20, 4761.21, 4761.301, 4761.31, 4761.32, 4761.33, 4761.34, 4761.35, 4761.36, 4761.37, 4761.38, 4761.381, 4761.39, 4761.40, 4761.41, 4761.43, 4761.44, 4761.45, and 4761.48 of the Revised Code to license advanced practice respiratory therapists and to amend the version of section 4761.01 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect September 30, 2024, to continue the change on and after that date.

To enact section 4729.71 of the Revised Code to establish the Canadian Prescription Drug Importation Program and to make an appropriation.

**H. B. No. 716** - Representatives Kelly, Jarrells.

Cosponsors: Representatives Galonski, Davis, Addison, Blackshear, Miranda, Ingram, Denson, Upchurch, Russo, Miller, A., SobECKi.

To amend sections 4111.14, 5122.28, and 5123.87; to enact new section

4111.06; and to repeal section 4111.06 of the Revised Code to eliminate subminimum wage for persons with physical or mental disabilities.

**H. B. No. 717** - Representative Wiggam.

To enact section 5534.902 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 226 in Wayne County as the "Wayne County Gold Star Family Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 718** - Representatives Davis, Crossman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Denson, Sobecki, Lepore-Hagan, Miller, A., Weinstein, Ingram, Smith, K., Miranda, Brent, Troy, Upchurch, Sweeney.

To amend section 1345.99 and to enact section 1345.033 of the Revised Code to prohibit price gouging of infant formula and to declare an emergency.

Said bills were considered the first time.
