INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 721 - Representatives Lightbody, Weinstein.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ingram, Russo, Smith, K., Liston, Miranda, Davis.

To amend sections 102.06 and 102.99 and to enact section 102.10 of the Revised Code to prohibit Ohio Supreme Court justices and statewide executive officers from holding other employment or paid positions.

H. B. No. 722 - Representatives Swearingen, Carruthers.

To amend sections 3314.03 and 3326.11 and to enact section 3313.473 of the Revised Code to enact the "Parents' Bill of Rights" to require public schools to adopt a prescribed policy on parental notification on student health and well-being and instructional materials with sexually explicit content.

Said bills were considered the first time.
