INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 726 - Representative Patton.

To amend section 323.155 and to enact section 319.303 of the Revised Code to allow certain counties to authorize a property tax freeze for certain owner-occupied homes.

H. B. No. 727 - Representatives Lanese, White.

Cosponsors: Representatives Holmes, Manning, Seitz.

To amend section 907.09 of the Revised Code to exempt the seed of certain native plant species from the agricultural seed law when used for specified purposes.

H. B. No. 728 - Representatives Miller, A., Stein.

Cosponsors: Representatives Weinstein, Davis, Brown, Miller, J., Sheehy, Gross, Crossman, Grendell, Troy, Sobecki, Kelly, Leland, Miranda, Blackshear, Liston, Lightbody, Galonski, Russo, Upchurch.

To amend sections 5919.34, 5919.341, and 5919.342 of the Revised Code to expand eligibility for the Ohio National Guard Scholarship Program and to rename that program as the Ohio National Guard and United States Armed Forces Reserve Scholarship Program.

Said bills were considered the first time.
