INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 739 - Representative Lipps.

To enact section 3792.05 of the Revised Code to prohibit a public or private school from discriminating against an individual based on COVID-19 vaccination status.

H. B. No. 740 - Representatives Miller, K., Plummer.

To enact sections 4511.253 and 4511.254 of the Revised Code to prohibit hooning and being a spectator at a hooning event.

H. B. No. 741 - Representatives Bird, Lipps.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lanese, Abrams, Holmes, Riedel, Gross, Schmidt, Young, T., Ray, Carruthers.

To enact section 5.282 of the Revised Code to designate the ninth day of April as "Yellow Ribbon Day."

H. B. No. 742 - Representative Lipps.

Cosponsors: Representatives Baldridge, Seitz, Carruthers.

To enact section 5162.137 of the Revised Code to require data collection, reporting, and outreach regarding applied behavior analysis for children with autism who are Medicaid enrollees.

H. B. No. 743 - Representatives Humphrey, Davis.

Cosponsors: Representatives Russo, Upchurch, Lightbody, Miller, J., Sobecki, Hicks-Hudson, Brent, Blackshear, Kelly, Denson, Miller, A., Miranda, Liston, Jarrells, Addison, Smith, M., Weinstein, White.

To enact sections 341.261, 753.321, and 5120.631 of the Revised Code to require municipal and county correctional facilities and state correctional institutions to provide inmates experiencing a menstrual cycle with an adequate supply of feminine hygiene products.
