INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 744 - Representative Manchester.

To amend section 5164.91 and to enact sections 173.525, 5162.137, 5166.122, and 5166.162 of the Revised Code regarding self-direction in certain Medicaid home and community-based services waiver programs.

H. B. No. 745 - Representatives LaRe, Bird. Cosponsors: Representatives Gross, Click.

To enact section 3319.225 of the Revised Code regarding notation of an educator's district or school of employment on license applications and notice of educator disciplinary actions and consent agreements.

H. B. No. 746 - Representative Ginter.

To enact section 5534.498 of the Revised Code to designate a bridge in Columbiana County as the "Captain Charles R. Miner Memorial Bridge."

H. B. No. 747 - Representative Lipps.

To enact section 3792.06 of the Revised Code to prohibit a private college or state institution of higher education from discriminating against an individual based on COVID-19 vaccination status.

H. B. No. 748 - Representative Bird.

To amend sections 3314.03 and 3326.11 and to enact section 3319.614 of the Revised Code to require each public school to adopt a policy regarding certain expectations related to the performance of staff member professional duties.

Said bills were considered the first time.
