### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills and joint resolution were introduced:

### H. B. No. 752 - Representative Stoltzfus.

Cosponsors: Representatives Roemer, West.

To enact section 5534.497 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 236 in Summit and Stark Counties as the "Patrolman Sean VanDenberg Memorial Highway."

### H. B. No. 753 - Representatives Seitz, Ray.

To amend sections 3702.511, 3702.59, and 3721.03 of the Revised Code regarding regulatory proceedings against certain long-term care facilities.

### H. B. No. 754 - Representative Wiggam.

To amend section 4301.62 and to enact section 4303.186 of the Revised Code to create the D-9 liquor permit, which authorizes an establishment to sell beer, wine, and mixed beverages for on-premises consumption under specified circumstances.

### H. J. R. No. 6 - Representative Stewart.

Proposing to amend Sections 1b, 1e, and 1g of Article II of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to require a vote of at least 60% of the electors to approve a constitutional amendment proposed by initiative petition.
