The following bill was introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 219 - Senator Craig.

Cosponsors: Senators Yuko, Maharath, Thomas, Antonio.

To amend sections 125.22, 4112.12, 4112.13, and 6301.10 of the Revised Code to change the name of a commission to the Commission on African-Americans, to modify membership of and to provide operating funding for the Commission, and to make an appropriation.

OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Romanchuk offered the following concurrent resolution:

S. C. R. No. 7-Senator Romanchuk.

To memorialize PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to urge the preservation of the Minimum Offer Price Rule for the PJM capacity market.
