INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 239 - Senator Blessing.

To amend section 3107.014 and to enact section 5103.57 of the Revised Code regarding qualifications for adoption and foster care home assessors and professional treatment staff.

S. B. No. 240 - Senator Peterson.

To enact sections 3314.0212, 3314.0213, 3314.0214, and 3314.0215 of the Revised Code authorizing the merger of one or more community schools and a nonprofit operator into a community school network.

S. B. No. 241 - Senators Cirino, Rulli.

Cosponsors: Senators Hackett, Lang.

To amend sections 135.143, 135.71, 135.73, and 135.82 and to repeal sections 135.631 and 135.731 of the Revised Code to expand the Agricultural Linked Deposit Program and the types of obligations in which the Treasurer of State may invest interim funds.

S. B. No. 242 - Senator Blessing.

To enact section 1333.97 of the Revised Code to require retail merchants to give customers the option to pay by cash.
