INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 360 - Senator Gavarone.

To amend section 124.136 of the Revised Code to expand paid parental leave benefits for certain state employees.

S. B. No. 361 - Senator Hoagland.

To amend section 3319.283 of the Revised Code to expand eligibility for veterans of the U.S. Armed Forces to be employed as teachers without licenses.

S. B. No. 362 - Senator Hoagland.

To amend sections 4503.10, 4503.11, 4503.191, and 4503.29 of the Revised Code to authorize a permanent motor vehicle registration option with a waiver of specified fees and taxes for retired military veterans under the Military License Plate Program.
