A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To rescind certain orders and rules in whole or in part. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The General Assembly has authority under section 2
101.36 of the Revised Code, as enacted by S.B. 22 of the 134th 3
General Assembly and effective June 23, 2021, to rescind, in 4
whole or in part, a special or standing order or rule for 5
preventing the spread of contagious or infectious disease issued 6
by the Department of Health under section 3701.13 of the Revised 7
Code; and 8

WHEREAS, The General Assembly has authority under section 9
107.43 of the Revised Code, as enacted by S.B. 22 of the 134th 10
General Assembly and effective June 23, 2021, to rescind, in 11
whole or in part, any order or rule issued or adopted by an 12

agency, or statewide elected officer in response to a state of 14
