WHEREAS, The "Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act," 18	8
U.S.C. 926(B) and 926(C), was enacted in 2004 to afford both	9
qualified active and qualified retired law enforcement officers	10
the right to carry concealed firearms; and	11
WHEREAS, The Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act was	12
expanded in 2010 to extend that privilege to Amtrak police,	13
which is a railroad police agency; and	14
WHEREAS, This expansion failed to extend the definition of	15
of "qualified law enforcement officer" and "qualified retired	16
law enforcement officer" to include all railroad police	17
officers, leaving several hundred officers excluded; now	18
therefore be it	19
