WHEREAS, The Windfall Elimination Provision was enacted in	3	
1983 to equalize the earned Social Security benefits of workers	4	
who spend part of their careers in exempt public service and	5	
workers who spend their entire careers participating in Social	6

WHEREAS, The Windfall Elimination Provision reduces the	8	
Social Security benefits of public servants who receive a	9	
pension for public service that was not subject to Social	10	
Security taxes; and	11	
WHEREAS, Members of the 117th United States Congress have	12	
introduced seven bills that would replace or repeal the Windfall	13	
Elimination Provision; and	14	
WHEREAS, There are 1.7 million members in Ohio's public	15	
retirement systems and over 450,000 beneficiaries and	16	
recipients; and	17	
WHEREAS, The Windfall Elimination Provision's flawed	18	
practical application diminishes nearly 150,000 Ohioans'	19	
retirement security and fails to recognize their rightfully	20
