**A R E S O L U T I O N**

To observe the month of November as Military Family Month. 1

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

WHEREAS, Recognizing November as Military Family Month 3  
provides all Ohioans with the opportunity to honor the daily 4  
sacrifices, selfless contributions, and exceptional patriotism 5  
of military families across the state and throughout the 6  
country; and 7

WHEREAS, Active-duty military family members in the United 8  
States form an important part of the country's military 9  
community, as approximately half of all active-duty service 10  
members have a spouse and more than one-third have children, 11  
according to data from the United States Department of Defense; 12  
and 13

WHEREAS, Families of military members are often required to 14  
spend extended periods of time away from their loved ones and to 15  
relocate frequently, sometimes through multiple deployments, all 16  
while maintaining household operations; and 17

WHEREAS, By supporting military families, we can help to 18  
ensure that members of the military are able to focus on their 19  
important mission of serving the state and country, knowing that 20  
their loved ones are cared for while they are away; and 21

WHEREAS, The Ohio Inter-Service Family Assistance Committee 22  
works diligently to collaborate and align resources in support 23  
of Ohio troops and military families; and 24

WHEREAS, Ohio has approximately 7,000 active-duty personnel 25  
and approximately 27,000 national guard and reserve personnel; 26  
now therefore be it 27

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the House of 28  
Representatives of the 134th General Assembly, recognize the 29  
month of November as Military Family Month to celebrate and 30  
acknowledge the ongoing contributions that military families 31  
make in support of their loved ones and in service to the 32  
country; and be it further 33

RESOLVED, That we urge all citizens to participate in 34  
appropriate programs and activities associated with Military 35  
Family Month; and be it further 36

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives 37  
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the 38  
Director of the Ohio Department of Veterans Services, the Ohio 39  
Adjutant General, and the news media of Ohio. 40
