BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, On April 9, 2021, President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. 4 issued Executive Order 14023 establishing the Presidential 5 Commission on the Supreme Court of the United States; and 6 7 WHEREAS, The Chairman of the House Judiciary Committee, Congressman Jerrold Nadler of New York, and members of the House 8 Judiciary Committee, Congressmen Mondaire Jones of New York and 9 Hank Johnson of Georgia, and Senator Edward J. Markey of 10 Massachusetts, have introduced the House Judiciary Act of 2021, 11 for the purpose of increasing the number of Justices on the 12 United States Supreme Court to the unprecedented number of 13

WHEREAS, The United States Supreme Court has never had less than five nor more than ten Justices; and

WHEREAS, For one hundred fifty-two years the Supreme Court of the United States has consisted of nine members; and

WHEREAS, President Franklin D. Roosevelt's efforts to "pack" the United States Supreme Court in the 1930s were, and are widely recognized as, an aggressive, chilling, and partially successful attempt to intimidate, and threaten the independence of, the United States Supreme Court, causing the court to look upon the President's programs more favorably than before, a change known commonly as the "change in time that saved nine"; and

WHEREAS, The late Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg once stated, in an interview on National Public Radio on July 24, 2019, "Nine seems to be a good number. It's been that way for a long time," and "I think it was a bad idea when President Franklin Roosevelt tried to pack the court," and "If anything would make the court appear partisan, it would be that - one side saying, 'When we're in power, we're going to enlarge the number of judges, so we would have more people who would vote the way we want them to'"; and

WHEREAS, Supreme Court Justice Stephen Breyer, in a speech to Harvard Law School on April 6, 2021, regarding the possibility of "packing" the United States Supreme Court, said "It is wrong to think of the Court as another political institution," and "Structural alteration motivated by the perception of political influence can only feed that perception, further eroding that trust"; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Attorney General David Yost stated, "The43court's orders are followed because the court is seen as44
