**A RESOLUTION**

Relative to the appointment and salaries of the officials 1  
and employees of the House of Representatives and 2  
empowering the Chief Administrative Officer to sign 3  
vouchers. 4

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF  
OHIO:**

BE IT RESOLVED, By the members of the House of Representatives of 5  
the 134th General Assembly, that in addition to those officers 6  
previously elected by resolution of the House, the Speaker is hereby 7  
authorized to appoint such additional staff as may be required for the 8  
purpose of facilitating the work of the House of Representatives and 9  
to fill any vacancies in positions as officers or employees; and be it 10  
further 11

RESOLVED, That the officers and employees of the House of 12  
Representatives be compensated as determined by the Chief 13  
Administrative Officer, with the approval of the Speaker; and be it 14  
further 15

RESOLVED, That pay increases shall be made only upon 16  
recommendation of the Chief Administrative Officer, with approval of 17  
the Speaker; and be it further 18

RESOLVED, That the Chief Administrative Officer shall have the 19  
direct supervision and management of those officers and employees who 20  
by reason of their duties fall within the specific area of 21  
responsibility of the Chief Administrative Officer. Pursuant to the 22

approval of the Speaker, the Chief Administrative Officer may 23  
discharge any officer or employee under their respective supervision 24  
if the officer or employee is not satisfactorily performing their 25  
duties; and be it further 26

RESOLVED, That this resolution shall govern all actions taken by 27  
the 134th General Assembly and that all of the foregoing salaries be 28  
paid from the appropriate funds of the House of Representatives; and 29  
be it further 30

RESOLVED, That except in cases in which the signature or approval of 31  
the speaker is required by law, the Chief Administrative Officer of the 32  
House is hereby directed and empowered to sign all vouchers to be 33  
presented to the auditor of state for the payment of any claim or claims 34  
against the state for service rendered, supplies furnished, money 35  
expended, or liabilities incurred in connection with the proper operation 36  
of the House of Representatives. 37
