WHEREAS, According to the United States Centers for Disease	3
Control and Prevention (CDC), as of January 21, 2021, 404,689	4
Americans have died as a result of COVID-19; and	5
WHEREAS, According to the Ohio Department of Health, that	6
number includes 9,402 confirmed COVID-19 deaths in Ohio; and	7
WHEREAS, The COVID-19 pandemic has disproportionately	8
affected communities of color in the United States, exacerbating	9
existing health disparities; and	10
WHEREAS, According to recent data from the CDC and the APM	11
Research Lab, Black, Latinx, Pacific Islander, and Indigenous	12
Americans have a COVID-19 death rate of double or more than of	13
white Americans; and	14
WHEREAS, According to the Kaiser Family Foundation, more	15
than 2,900 American health care workers have died in the COVID-	16
19 pandemic; and	17
WHEREAS, Older adults and people with underlying health	18
conditions are also at higher risk of death from COVID-19 than	19
