Maloney, Jr., and extend our heartfelt condolences to his family and

WHEREAS, Michael Maloney left an indelible impression on the
people whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a spirited
man who contributed immeasurably to the world around him. A U.S. Air
Force veteran of the Korean War and an employee of the *Cincinnati*
Enquirer, he was appointed to the Ohio Senate in 1964, and over the
course of his fourteen-year tenure with the General Assembly of Ohio,
he served as chair of the Ways and Means Committee and as the Minority
Whip. In addition, he served as an administrator and auditor for
Hamilton County, and he achieved a noteworthy record of success
throughout his varied and distinguished career; and

WHEREAS, Michael Maloney's regard for improving the quality of
life in our society was clearly evident in his personal sacrifices of
time and effort to his family, friends, and community. Giving
generously of his energy and abilities in all of his endeavors, he
displayed exceptional concern and insight, and his absence will be

WHEREAS, Michael Maloney was a devoted husband to his wife, the
late Mary, a loving father to his six children, Tim, Dick, Pat, Tom,
Brigid, and the late Michael, and a doting grandfather to his twelve
grandchildren, and he always used his talents to the benefit of
others. Indeed, the laurels of his life stand as a tribute not only to
him but also to those he left behind, and although the void his death
has created can never be filled, the legacy of care and commitment he
