To urge the President of the United States not to	1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, The United States Secretary of Defense, with the	5						
endorsement of President Biden, is requiring members of the	6						
armed forces to submit to a COVID-19 vaccination that is fully							
approved by the Food and Drug Administration; and							
WHEREAS, The United States Air Force is requiring active	9						
duty members to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by November	10						
2, 2021; and	11						
WHEREAS, The United States Navy is requiring all members to	12						
be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by November 28, 2021, and							
all Navy Reserve members by December 28, 2021; and							
WHEREAS, The United States Marine Corps is requiring all	15						
active-duty members to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by	16						
November 28, 2021, and all reservists by December 28, 2021; and	17						
WHEREAS, The United States Air Force National Guard and Air	18						
Force Reserve are requiring members to be fully vaccinated	19						
against COVID-19 by December 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, The United States Army is requiring all activeduty members to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by December 15, 2021, and all National Guard members by June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The United States Army released a statement24detailing that soldiers who refuse to submit to a COVID-1925vaccination "will first be counseled by their chain of command26and medical providers" and "continued failure to comply could27result in administrative or non-judicial punishment - to include28relief of duties or discharge"; and29

WHEREAS, The United States Army has further stated, 30
"Commanders, command sergeants major, first sergeants and 31
officers in Command Select List...positions who refuse to be 32
vaccinated - and are not pending an exemption request - face 33
suspension and relief if they refuse to comply"; and 34

WHEREAS, The United States Army has further stated, "Officers and noncommissioned officers who have been selected and are waiting to assume [Command Select List] command, key billet or nominative sergeant major positions...will likewise be subject to removal from the list for those assignments should they refuse to be vaccinated without a pending or approved exemption"; and

WHEREAS, Such reprimands can be career-ending, according to the United States Army; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the Ohio Senate of the 134th General Assembly, urge the President not to allow members of the United States Armed Forces to be punished or reprimanded in any way, including discharge, for refusing to submit to a COVID-19 vaccination; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Ohio Senate transmit duly 49 authenticated copies of this resolution to the President of the 50 United States, the United States Secretary of Defense, all 51
