**A RESOLUTION**

Recognizing Veterans Day, November 11, 2021.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 134th General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize November 11, 2021, as Veterans Day; and

WHEREAS, Armistice Day was established when representatives of the Allies and Germany signed a peace agreement in Compiègne, France, to formally end World War I on November 11, 1918. That date became a national holiday in the United States in 1938, and in 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower officially changed the name of the holiday to Veterans Day. During World War I, approximately 263,000 Ohioans served our nation and 6,500 made the ultimate sacrifice, and the members of the Ohio Senate honor the memory of those brave Ohioans who fought in World War I, for they were a key to the Allied victory; and

WHEREAS, Since its establishment, Veterans Day has become a time to honor not only those who participated in World War I but all those who have served in the U.S. Armed Forces, during both war and peacetime. On this solemn occasion, the citizens of Ohio have the opportunity to reflect on the sacrifices of the past and to express their profound gratitude to all veterans; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that we openly acknowledge our debt to those who bore our country's standard with courage, dignity, and decency through their military service. Veterans come from all ranks and strata of society, for they are our children, our parents, our grandparents, our friends, our neighbors, and our co-workers, and it is by their service and patriotism that the light of our nation continues to endure for future generations; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the Senate of the 134th General

Assembly of Ohio, in adopting this Resolution, recognize November 11, 27  
2021, as Veterans Day and encourage all citizens to remember the 28  
Ohioans who have served our country and its military forces; and be it 29
