To amend section 315.02 of the Revised Code to
modify the qualifications of county engineers in
certain counties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 315.02 of the Revised Code be
amended to read as follows:

Sec. 315.02. (A) No person holding the office of clerk of
the court of common pleas, sheriff, county treasurer, or county
recorder is eligible to hold the office of county engineer. ~~No~~

(B) (1) Except as provided in division (B) (2) of this
section, no person is eligible in any county as a candidate for
such the office of county engineer or shall be elected or
appointed thereto unless ~~he~~ the person is a registered
professional engineer and a registered surveyor, licensed to
practice in this state.

(2) In a county with a population of less than forty
thousand according to the most recent federal decennial census,
a person being elected or appointed to the person's first term
as county engineer in that county is not required to be a
registered surveyor licensed to practice in this state.
