#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3727.11, 3727.12, 3727.13, and	6
3727.14 be amended and section 3727.131 of the Revised Code be	7
enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 3727.11. A hospital shall not represent itself as a	9
comprehensive stroke center, thrombectomy-capable stroke center,	10
primary stroke center, or acute stroke ready hospital unless it	11
is recognized as such by the department of health under section	12
3727.13 of the Revised Code.	13
This section does not prohibit a hospital from	14
representing itself as having a relationship or affiliation with	15
a hospital recognized by the department of health under section	16
3727.13 of the Revised Code or a hospital in another state that	17

information, statistics, or other data that is collected, only	164
samples are to be transmitted for inclusion in the stroke	165

(4) Notwithstanding any provision of section 121.95 of the	169
Revised Code to the contrary, a regulatory restriction contained	170
in a rule adopted under this section is not subject to sections	171
121.95 to 121.953 of the Revised Code.	172
(D)(1) Except as provided in division (D)(2) of this	173
section, each hospital that is recognized by the department	174
under section 3727.13 of the Revised Code as a comprehensive	175
stroke center, thrombectomy-capable stroke center, or primary	176
stroke center shall do both of the following:	177
(a) Collect the information, statistics, and other data	178
specified by the director in rules adopted under division (B) of	179
this section;	180
(b) Transmit the information, statistics, and other data	181
for inclusion in the stroke registry database.	182
A hospital may contract with a third-party organization	183
for the collection and transmission of the information,	184
statistics, and other data. If a hospital contracts with a	185
third-party organization, the organization shall collect and	186
transmit such information, statistics, and other data for	187

(2) The data described in division (B)(1)(b)(ii) of this	189
section shall be collected and transmitted only by a hospital	190
that is recognized by the department under section 3727.13 of	191
the Revised Code as a thrombectomy-capable stroke center.	192
(3) In the case of a hospital that is recognized by the	193
department under section 3727.13 of the Revised Code as an acute	194
stroke ready hospital, the collection and transmission of the	195
data described in division (B) of this section is encouraged.	196
(E) The information, statistics, or other data collected	197

If established, the membership of the committee shall	204

Sec. 3727.14. If an accrediting organization approved by	212
the federal centers for medicare and medicaid services or an	213
organization that certifies hospitals in accordance with	214
nationally recognized certification guidelines establishes a	215
level of stroke certification that is in addition to the three-	216
four levels described in sections 3727 11 to 3727 13 of the	217

As Reported by the House Health Provider Services Committee  Revised Code, the department of health shall recognize a hospital certified at that additional level.	
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For purposes of this section, the department and a	220
hospital shall comply with sections 3727.11 to 3727.13 of the	221
Revised Code as if the certification and recognition described	222
in this section were one of the three four levels described in	223
sections 3727.11 to 3727.13 of the Revised Code.	224
Section 2. That existing sections 3727.11, 3727.12,	225
3727.13, and 3727.14 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	226
