The registrar shall pay the contributions received 19 pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 2.0 cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 21 programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 22 cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 23 quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 24 the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 25 other abortion-related activities. 26
