Section 3. The provisions of law contained in this act,

Section 4. The sections of law contained in this act, and 28 the items of law of which the sections of law contained in this 29 act are composed, are not subject to the referendum under Ohio 30 Constitution, Article II, Section 1d and section 1.471 of the 31 Revised Code and therefore go into immediate effect when this 32 act becomes law. 33
