A BILL

To amend	section 5747.48 and to enact section	1
3375.6	8 of the Revised Code to require each	2
board	of public library trustees to adopt a	3
policy	that prohibits its libraries from	4
displa	ying matter harmful to juveniles and to	5
redist	ribute the public library funds of	6
librar	ies that fail to do so.	7

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5747.48 be amended and section	8	
3375.68 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	9	
Sec. 3375.68. (A) As used in this section, "harmful to	10	
juveniles" has the same meaning as in section 2907.01 of the	11	
Revised Code.	12	
(B) Each board of public library trustees shall adopt a	13	
policy that requires each library under its control to do both	14	
of the following:	15	
(1) Prohibit patrons under eighteen years of age from	16	
borrowing or viewing materials that are harmful to juveniles		
unless the library has received parental consent with respect to		
any item to be viewed or borrowed by the patron;		

(2) Conceal from viewing any materials that are harmful to	20	
juveniles so that the materials are not open to view by		
juveniles as part of the invited general public.	22	
(C) A library may comply with the requirement in division	23	
(A) (2) of this section by doing any of the following with	24	
respect to material that is harmful to juveniles:	25	
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<u>(1) Placing the material behind blinder racks or similar</u>	26	
devices that cover at least the lower two-thirds of the	27	
<pre>material;</pre>	28	
(2) Wrapping the material;	29	
(3) Placing the material behind a circulation counter;	30	
(4) Otherwise covering the material or locating it so that	31	
the portion that is harmful to juveniles is not open to the view	32	
<u>of juveniles.</u>	33	
(D)(1) A resident of this state who believes that a	34	
library is not complying with the requirements of division (B)	35	
or (C) of this section may file a complaint with the state	36	
library board. Upon receiving the complaint, the state library	37	
board shall investigate whether the library is complying with	38	
the requirements of division (B) or (C) of this section. If the	39	
board determines that the library is not complying with such a	40	
requirement, the board shall submit a report of the board's	41	
determination to the county treasurer of any county from which	42	
the library receives distributions from the county public	43	
library fund under section 5747.48 of the Revised Code.	44	
(2) Upon the request of a board of public library trustees	45	
of a library reported under division (D)(1) of this section as	46	
failing to comply with the requirements of division (B) or (C)	47	
of this section, the state library board shall evaluate whether		

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the library is compliant with those requirements. If the state	49
library board determines that the library is in compliance with	50
those requirements, the board promptly shall issue an addendum	51
to the board's original report concerning the library to the	52
county treasurer of any county from which the library receives	53
distributions from the county public library fund under section	54
5747.48 of the Revised Code.	

Sec. 5747.48. (A) On the fifteenth day of each month, the county treasurer shall distribute the balance in the county public library fund among the county, boards of public library trustees, municipal corporations, and boards of township park commissioners for which the county budget commission has fixed an allocation from the fund in that year in accordance with section 5705.32 of the Revised Code in the same proportions that each such entity's allocation as fixed by the commission is of the total of all such allocations in that year, except as provided in division (B) of this section.

All money received into the treasury of a municipal 66 corporation or county shall be credited to the general fund 67 therein, provided that in a municipal corporation there shall be 68 credited to the funds established under division (D) of section 69 5705.09 of the Revised Code a portion of the total amount to be 70 credited to funds of the municipal corporation, which portion 71 shall be determined by multiplying the total amount to be 72 credited by the percentage that the funds credited under 73 division (D) of said section in 1938 bore to all the funds 74 credited under said section in 1938. If a municipal corporation 75 is in default with respect to the principal or interest of any 76 outstanding notes or bonds, the moneys distributed under this 77 section shall be credited to the funds established under 78 divisions (A), (B), (C), and (D) of section 5705.09 of the 79

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Revised Code, in the same proportion in which the funds derived from the levy for the previous year on the general tax list and duplicate are divided.

(B) A county treasurer that has received a report 83 described in division (D)(1) of section 3375.68 of the Revised 84 Code shall not make the monthly payments otherwise required 85 under division (A) of this section to the board of public 86 library trustees of a library that is the subject of that 87 notice, beginning with the next required payment. Instead, the 88 county treasurer shall distribute any such payments among the 89 other boards of public library trustees, the county, and the 90 municipal corporations and boards of township park commissioners 91 fixed an allocation from the county public library fund. The 92 amount allocated to each board or subdivision shall equal the 93 amount of the forgone payment multiplied by a fraction, the 94 numerator of which is the amount of the board's or subdivision's 95 allocation for the applicable month, not accounting for any 96 adjustment required by this division, and the denominator of 97 which is the sum of the allocations of all such boards or 98 subdivisions for that month, not accounting for any adjustment_ 99 required by this division. 100

The county treasurer shall cease making the adjustment101described in this division beginning with the next payment102following the date the treasurer receives the addendum described103in division (D) (2) of section 3375.68 of the Revised Code.104

Section 2. That existing section 5747.48 of the Revised 105 Code is hereby repealed. 106

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
