Section 1. That section 705.19 of the Revise	ed Code be	4

5 amended to read as follows: Sec. 705.19. (A) No money shall be drawn from the treasury 6 7 of a municipal corporation except in pursuance of appropriations made by the legislative authority, and whenever an appropriation is so made the clerk shall forthwith give notice to the auditor and treasurer. Appropriations may be made in furtherance of 10 improvements or other objects or work of the municipal 11 corporation which will not be completed within the current year. 12 At the end of each year all unexpended balances of 13 appropriations shall revert to the respective funds from which 14 they were appropriated and shall then be subject to future 15 appropriations. 16 7

(B) A municipal corporation charter or ordinance shall not	17

(C) A charter provision or ordinance that violates	24
division (B) of this section is void and has no legal effect.	25
Section 2. That existing section 705.19 of the Revised	26
Code is hereby repealed.	27
Section 3. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	28
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	29
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to	30
prevent municipal corporations from circumventing current	31
appropriations law, ensuring the responsible stewardship of	32
treasury funds and preventing the interruption of local peace,	33

health, and safety services. Therefore, this act shall go into

immediate effect.
