(1) "Local government" means a township, county, or	13

(2) "Short-term rental property" means a house, apartment,	15
condominium, cooperative unit, cabin, cottage, or bungalow, or	16
one or more rooms therein, that is, or are, offered to	17

transients or travelers for a fee for a period of thirty days or

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less, regardless of whether amenities, including meals, daily	19
housekeeping, concierge services, or linen services, are	20

(B) A local government may require the registration of	22

property for the purposes of protecting the public health,	24
safety, and welfare with respect to any of the following:	25
(1) Noise;	26
(2) The number of individuals who may occupy a dwelling;	27
(3) Housing and property maintenance;	28
(4) Health and sanitation;	29

(6) Solid and hazardous waste and pollution control;	31
(7) Liability insurance covering loss or liability for	32

(D) Any fee associated with the registration of a short-	46
term rental property shall be reasonable and shall be used by	47
