INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

To enact section 3321.043 of the Revised Code to require school districts to grant students excused absences from school for participation in 4-H and FFA programs and activities.

H. B. No. 136 - Representatives Holmes, Stewart.

To amend section 4729.285 and to enact section 4729.554 of the Revised Code to authorize the operation of remote dispensing pharmacies.

H. B. No. 137 - Representatives Mathews, Plummer.

To require the Department of Education to study the feasibility of implementing a program similar to the Kentucky Bluegrass Challenge Academy.

To amend section 5747.01 of the Revised Code to classify certain guaranteed payments to pass-through entity investors as business income.
