INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 145 - Representatives Hall, Lampton.

To amend section 9.48 of the Revised Code to expand political subdivision joint purchasing authority to expressly include purchases for construction services.

H. B. No. 146 - Representative Bird.

To enact section 3309.363 of the Revised Code to establish a contribution based benefit cap in calculating a School Employees Retirement System member's retirement benefit.

H. B. No. 147 - Representatives Fowler Arthur, Miller, A.
Cosponsors: Representatives Dean, Johnson, Willis.

To amend sections 3319.31 and 3319.313 of the Revised Code regarding teacher licensure revocation, teacher hiring practices, and conduct unbecoming to the teaching profession.

H. B. No. 148 - Representative Dell'Aquila.
Cosponsors: Representatives Galonski, Troy, Upchurch, Forhan, McNally, Abdullahi, Brennan.

To amend sections 2905.05 and 2950.01 of the Revised Code to require that a person act with a sexual motivation to commit the offense of criminal child enticement.

H. B. No. 149 - Representative Willis.

To enact sections 4561.60, 4561.61, 4561.62, 4561.63, 4561.64, and 4561.65 of the Revised Code to establish requirements related to the use of an uncrewed aerial vehicle for surveillance.

H. B. No. 150 - Representatives Upchurch, Miller, A.
Cosponsors: Representatives Galonski, Brent, Brewer, McNally, Miller, J., Lightbody, Denson, Skindell, Rogers, Abdullahi, Forhan, Weinstein, Mohamed, Isaacsohn.

To amend sections 4112.01 and 4112.02 of the Revised Code to prohibit discrimination in rental housing based on lawful source of income.
