INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 396 - Representatives Brennan, Williams.

Cosponsors: Representatives Baker, Carruthers, Click, Creech, Dell'Aquila, Dobos, Forhan, Hoops, Humphrey, John, Johnson, Klopfenstein, Lampton, Lear, Lipps, Lorenz, McNally, Miller, J., Miller, K., Pizzulli, Plummer, Richardson, Robb Blasdel, Schmidt, Seitz, Stein, Sweeney, White, Willis, Young, T.

To provide funding for the replacement of police dogs imprinted to detect marijuana, to reimburse those expenses from adult use excise tax revenue, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 397 - Representatives Hoops, Baker.

To enact section 3701.147 of the Revised Code to increase education, awareness, and understanding of cognitive impairment, Alzheimer's disease, and other types of dementia.

H. B. No. 398 - Representatives Miranda, Abdullahi.

To enact section 4113.12 of the Revised Code to prohibit employers from seeking a prospective employee's wage or salary history.

H. B. No. 399 - Representatives Brown, Lampton.

To amend section 5747.01 and to enact section 5747.74 of the Revised Code to modify the existing income tax credit for organ donors and to create an income tax credit for employers that provide paid leave to organ donors.

H. B. No. 400 - Representatives Callender, Sweeney.

Cosponsors: Representatives Baker, Isaacsohn, Brown, Denson, Carruthers, Brennan, Seitz, Piccolantonio, Rogers, Abrams, Thomas, C.

To amend section 3923.33 and to enact section 3923.3310 of the Revised Code to provide Medigap policies for Medicare-eligible individuals under the age of 65.

Said bills were considered the first time.
