The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Dobos was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 455 - Representatives Patton, Manning.

To enact section 149.60 of the Revised Code to establish the Ohio Ireland Trade Commission.

H. B. No. 456 - Representative McNally.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, Piccolantonio, Rogers, Robb Blasdel.

To enact section 5534.441 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 170 within the municipal corporation of New Middletown as the "Police Chief Ronnie Ricketts, Sr. Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 457 - Representative Click.

Cosponsors: Representatives Bird, Claggett, Dean, Gross, Klopfenstein, Wiggam.

To amend sections 3503.14, 3503.15, 3503.20, 3503.21, and 3503.33 of the Revised Code to modify the voter registration forms and procedures for electors who have previously registered in another state or county.

H. B. No. 458 - Representative Hoops.

To enact sections 5534.878 and 5534.879 of the Revised Code to designate a bridge and a viaduct that are located in the Village of Montpelier, in Williams County, as the "Gold and Blue Star Family Memorial Bridge" and the "POW/MIA Memorial Viaduct"

H. B. No. 459 - Representative Cutrona.

To enact section 5.56 of the Revised Code to designate March 25 as Greek Independence Day.

H. B. No. 460 - Representatives Hillyer, Seitz.

To amend section 2953.32 and to enact section 2953.321 of the Revised Code to enact the Getting Rehabilitated Ohioans Working Act to allow for the automatic sealing of certain criminal records.

H. B. No. 461 - Representative Lorenz.

To amend section 4301.62 and to enact section 4303.2013 of the Revised Code to create the F-13 liquor permit to allow the on-premises sale of beer or intoxicating liquor at a business that is not otherwise qualified to obtain a liquor permit.

H. B. No. 462 - Representatives Troy, Brennan.

To enact section 3333.27 of the Revised Code to enact the Student Choice Grant Program and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 463 - Representative Click.

Cosponsors: Representatives Barhorst, Dean, Gross, Klopfenstein, Kick, McClain, Richardson, Wiggam, Williams.

To enact section 3798.05 of the Revised Code related to medical records of minors and to name the act the My Child-My Chart Act.

H. B. No. 464 - Representatives Jarrells, Williams.

Cosponsors: Representatives McNally, Isaacsohn, Upchurch, Somani, Brewer, Miller, A., Miller, J., Miranda, Grim, Piccolantonio, Russo, Brown, Click.

To establish the 'A HAND UP' pilot program, to designate this act as the Actionable Help And New Dignity for Upward Progression (A HAND UP) Act, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 465 - Representative Carruthers.

To enact sections 5124.81, 5124.82, 5124.83, 5124.84, 5124.85, 5124.86, 5124.87, 5124.88, and 5166.201 of the Revised Code to permit a resident of an ICF/IID to conduct electronic monitoring of the resident's room, to establish a new Medicaid home and community-based services waiver for individuals with developmental disabilities, and to name this act Lauren's Law.

To amend sections 4735.55, 4735.56, and 4735.59 of the Revised Code to require a written agency agreement for a licensed broker to represent a buyer or seller in a real estate transaction.

To amend sections 3501.05, 3513.06, 3513.07, 3513.261, and 3513.271 of the Revised Code to create an exemption to the requirement that candidates must provide all names used in the past five years.
