The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 3, the Clerk called the Senate to order.

The journal of the last legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 30 - Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Senators Cirino, Wilson.

To amend section 4109.07 of the Revised Code to allow a person under sixteen years of age to be employed after 7 p.m. during the school year.

S. B. No. 31 - Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Senators Cirino, Reineke.

To enact section 4141.433 of the Revised Code to establish legislative oversight of executive action regarding voluntary federal unemployment compensation programs.

S. B. No. 32 - Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Senators Cirino, Johnson.

To amend section 2923.126 of the Revised Code to generally grant civil immunity for certain injuries to a person who acts in self-defense or defense of another during the commission, or imminent commission, of an offense of violence to protect the members or guests of a nonprofit corporation under certain circumstances.

S. B. No. 33 - Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsor: Senator Cirino.

To enact section 5162.213 of the Revised Code to require Medicaid applicants to certify that they have been notified about the Medicaid estate recovery program.

S. B. No. 34 - Senator Schaffer.

To enact section 5.271 of the Revised Code to designate July as "Sarcoma Awareness Month" and to name the act Hank's Law.

S. B. No. 35 - Senators Hoagland, O'Brien.

To amend section 109.803 and to enact section 109.802 of the Revised Code and to amend Section 701.70 of H.B. 110 of the 134th General

Assembly, as subsequently amended, to create the Law Enforcement Assistance Fund to reimburse for specified costs of peace officer and trooper continuing professional training, to create the Law Enforcement Equipment Fund to provide grants to small local law enforcement agencies to be used for purchasing law enforcement equipment, and to make an appropriation.
