## INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 136 - Senator Craig.

To amend sections 323.152, 323.153, 323.156, and 4503.06 of the Revised Code to reduce property taxes on qualifying owner-occupied homes and to name this act the Property Tax Relief and Local Government Support Act.

S. B. No. 137 - Senator Gavarone, DeMora.

To amend sections 3501.01 and 5747.502 and to enact sections 3505.011, 3513.141, 5747.504, and 5747.505 of the Revised Code to generally prohibit the use of ranked choice voting and to withhold Local Government Fund distributions from a municipality or chartered county that uses ranked choice voting.
